



Metro: line 2 and 6 stop at Trône /Troon






Station Porte de Namur/Naamsepoort

Metro: line 2 and 6 stop at Namur/Naamsepoort


Bus: 34/64/71/80 stop at Namur/Naamsepoort



By car

You can park at the **parking garage 'Parking Deux Portes'** Boulevard de Waterloo, 2A – 1000 Bruxelles

From there it's a 5-minute walk to the event location.



'Parking Deux Portes' is open Monday to Saturday from 6:30 a.m. to 2 a.m., Sunday and public holidays from 12 p.m. to 2 a.m.

Reaching the Universitaire Stichting (Fondation Universitaire) from Brussels Airport

By train

• The airport train station is located below the terminal (basement level-1). Up to 4 trains an hour connect the airport to Brussels North, Brussels Central, and Brussels Midi stations.

A one-way ticket costs €8,50 second class, including the Diabolo fee.

- By metro from the Central station (Gare Central), take Metro 1 direction Herrmann-Debroux until station Arts-Loi (2 stops).
 Then take Metro 2 direction Simonis (Leopold I)I until station Trône (1 stop).
 Exit rue du Luxembourg.
- By metro from the South station (Gare Midi/Zuid), take Metro 2 direction Simonis (Elisabeth) until station Trône (5 stops).
 Exit rue du Luxembourg.
- Cost of a single ticket : €2,00

By taxi

Taxis with a taximeter are permanently available in front of the arrivals hall of Brussels Airport. The fare from the airport to the city center of Brussels is normally around \notin 45.

Licensed taxis can be recognized by the blue and yellow emblem. Travelers are advised to avoid unlicensed taxis!

By bus Number 12

The bus station in Brussels Airport is located on level 0 - one floor down from the arrivals hall - and can be easily reached by using the escalators or elevators.

MIVB/STIB

The Airport Line is a 30-minute express service between Brussels Airport and the European quarter.

From Monday to Friday 8 pm the Airport Line is operated as an express service with **number 12** and only serves the major stops.

On weekdays after 8 pm, and the whole day on Saturday, Sunday, and holidays the Airport Line is operated as a regular service with **number 21**, serving all stops.

All MIVB/STIB buses depart from platform C.

In order to save time and money, buy your ticket from the GO ticket vending machines before boarding (€4 for a single ticket). These machines accept Maestro bank cards, credit cards, and coins.

Tickets bought from the driver are more expensive ($\in 6$).

The bus stop nearest to the Universitaire Stichting is **Station Brussels-Luxembourg** (for both numbers **12** and **21**).
